Summary	 The project partners have identified a common set of issues that they propose to address in order to provide better services for citizens. The main activities of the project are: Organizing 3 exchange of experience and 1 online meeting (each partner will host one experience exchange and will attend the other 2 organised by the other partners) Organizing events to promote the project (opening and closing conferences) Creating a common network of best practices in administration; Purchase of equipment for the endowment of the partner town halls, in order to serve the communities (LB: 1 vehicle with minimum 6 seats for persons and 1 vehicle to carry equipment, PP2: 2 minibuses, necessary for transportation of persons - type 8 + 1, PP3: 6+ 1 crew cabin chassis with tipper, 1 teleconference system) The Programme Output Indicator is 11/b 1 Number of institutions directly involved in cross-border cooperation initiatives. Through the project ROHU-319, 3 institutions are directly involved in cross-border cooperation initiatives.
Main results	Within the partnership, as a result of the activities, the 3 partners will progress in providing better services to citizens and will initiate cooperation in other specific areas, such as water resource management, waste management, transport, etc. After the implementation of the project, the partners will develop short-term action plans (at 1 year from the end of project implementation) and medium-term action plans (at least 5 years). The institutions will benefit from new facilities and will be able to continue their cooperation. A common strategy for economic growth and tourism development could also be developed. By implementing this project, the level of cooperation between 3 institutions in the cross-border region will increase.
